

Summer League Final 2006 FAQ

1. Where and when will the League Final be held?

League Final will be held at Turf City (First 4 Football fields) on 30th July 2006 (Sunday).

2. What time do the teams have to report?

First game will start at 9am. It is advisable for teams playing the first game to be at the fields and do your warm-up starting from 8am. Please refer to Appendix A for schedule for the day.

3. Is there parking available near the fields?

Players can park their vehicles at any of Turf City car park or at the service road beside the fields at no extra charges. Vehicles are parked at owner's own risk (as with any public car park) and vehicle owners are not to park their vehicles indiscriminately / haphazardly or in any way cause obstruction to the service road. Please refer to Appendix B for the available parking areas and direction to service road.

4. How many fields will there be?

There will be 3 fields available for usage altogether.

5. What are the games formats like?

i) **Pool games** – Teams are grouped into 2 pools of 3 teams each. For pools games, each will be play to game 13 points or hardcap at 75mins (game inclusive of 10mins half-time break and 3x 2mins time-out). The top 2 teams from each pool will proceed to the Semi. The last team of each pool will proceed to the consolation game.

ii) In event of 3-ways tie, we will look in the order of “Goal Difference”, “Goal For” and lastly “Goal Against” to decide the winner.

iii) **Semi / Consolation games** – Teams will play to 15 points or hardcap at 90mins (game inclusive of 10mins half-time break and 3x 2mins time-out).

iv) **Final** – Final teams will play to 15 points or hardcap at 120mins (game inclusive of 10mins half-time break and 3x 2mins time-out)

IMPORTANT - If any team is not ready at the game's start time, for every 5mins passed, the opponent team will be awarded 1 point. There will not be any extension or delay of game time (except for rain), all the teams will follow the organising committee's time clock.

6. Will water and ice be provided?

Yes. Each player will be given 2 bottles of 1.5 liters of mineral water for the day. There are 2 water taps available at the side of the field. Although according to the field owner, the water is drinkable, the organising committee will not be liable if any players fall sick after drinking from the tap water. Ice will also be available during the Final.

7. Will food be provided?

Yes. Light lunch and dinner buffet will be provided in the late morning and towards the end of the day. Unfortunately due to budget constraints, the organising committee is unable to ensure there's enough food for everyone. Players are recommended to bring along some food or they can visit the food stores or fast food restaurant at Turf City if they are still hungry. Please refer to the Appendix C for the list of food provided.

8. Will there be toilets available?

Yes. There will be 2 portable toilets available at a short distance from the fields. Players can also visit the toilets located at Turf City.

9. Will shelters be available?

Yes. Tents will be available to provide shades for players during their rest or rain.

10. Are 'floaters' allowed in this league?

We allow floaters but we leave it to the discretion of the opposing team captains whether to accept any particular floater. Floaters please pay the organising committee \$10 for floating in the Final.

11. What happen in event of bad weather e.g. heavy rain?

The field owner (First 4 Football) holds the final decision if the fields are suitable for playing without damaging the fields. As such, there is a risk of cancellation of the event anytime if it rains heavily. Players are advised to perform more good deeds during the week for good karma so that we get perfect weather.

Unfortunately, food catered need 3 days in advance for cancellation thus players are highly encourage to stay for food even if we have to cancel the games due to heavy rain.

12. Are there awards for the Final?

Prizes will be awarded to the regular League Season Winner and the Final Tournament Champion. There will not be any individual awards for this Summer League.

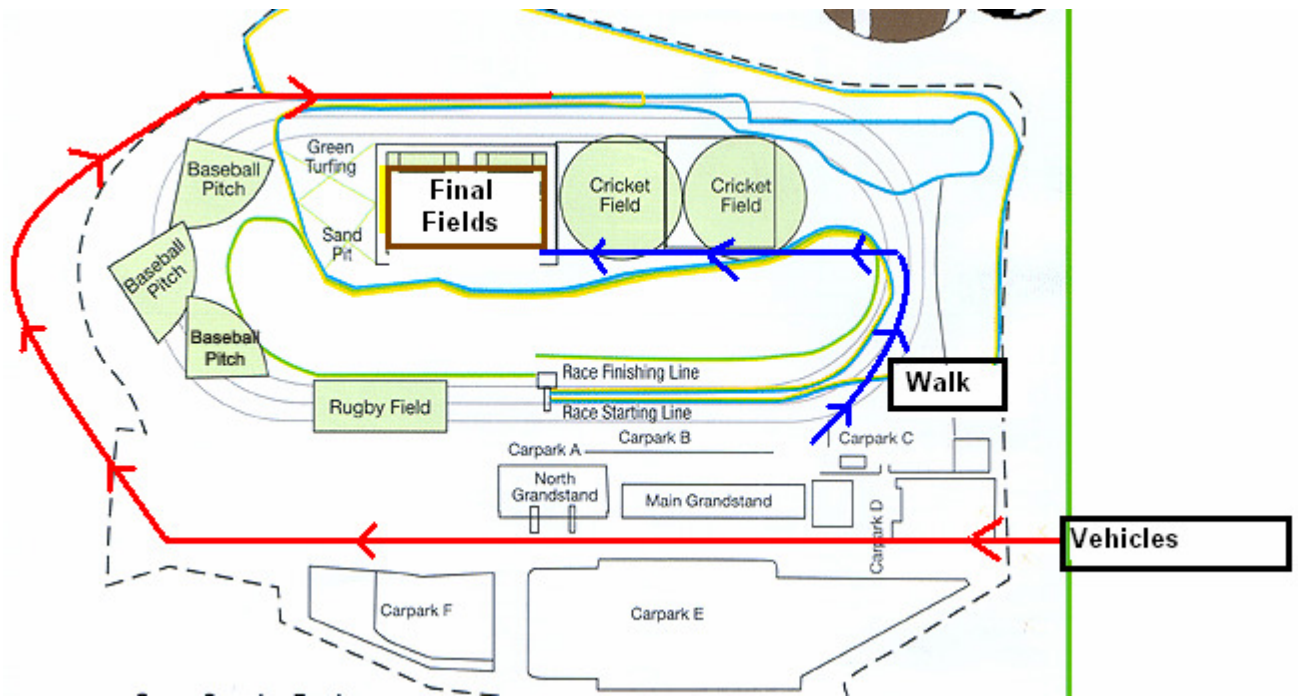
13. Will there be a league party?

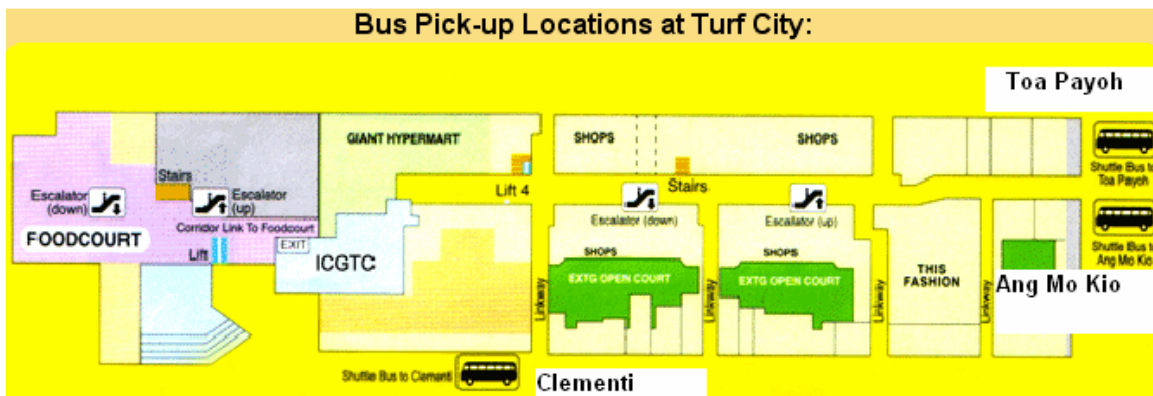
Appendix B
